



**ROUGH CREEK LODGE & RESORT**

We are very much looking forward to your visit at Rough Creek Lodge. Our hunting staff has proven to be the best in the world and we know you're going to have a great hunting experience. However, and due to a change in Texas Parks and Wildlife policy, we no longer have the capability to sell hunting licenses on premises.

This will necessitate your acquiring a Texas Hunting License prior to your arrival. If you already have a license please make sure that it has not expired. All licenses expire on August 31, of the current year.

If you don't possess a Hunting License here are some easy options to obtain one. Please remember you will need to provide a proper ID, either a valid drivers license or a state issued ID card and a Social Security Number (not the actual card). Children (ages 16 years old and younger) will not need to produce any ID but the parent must provide the Child's social security number. The Child is not required to be present when the Parent purchases the Child's license.

You can purchase your appropriate Hunting License at the following locations or ON LINE at [www.tpwd.state.tx.us/](http://www.tpwd.state.tx.us/). "PLEASE REMEMBER" to state the license needed for the type of hunting *in which you are participating*. Any area Wal-Mart, Academy Sports and Outdoors, Dicks Sporting Goods, Sports Authority, Bass Pro, Cabellas, Ace Hardware, as well as most gun shops sell Hunting Licenses.

TYPE OF HUNTING	LICENSE REQUIRED	COST FOR TEXAS RESIDENT
Deer, Varmint (including Hogs)	General Hunting License	\$25
Upland Bird	General Hunting License	\$25 plus \$7 stamp for Upland Bird
Turkey	General Hunting License	\$25 plus \$7 stamp for Turkey
Duck	General Hunting License	\$25 plus \$17 stamp for Duck

**OR**

Super Combo Licenses will include ALL stamps including Migratory Birds (Dove) and the cost is \$68.

**Who needs to take Hunter Education?** Every hunter (including out-of-state hunters) born on or after September 2, 1971, must successfully complete a Hunter Education Training Course. Minimum age of certification is 9 years and cost is \$15.00. If, you were born on or after September 2, 1971 and you are:

- Under 9 years of age, you must be accompanied\*.
- Age 9 through 16, you must successfully complete a hunter education course, **OR** you must be accompanied.
- Age 17 and over, you must successfully complete a hunter education course; or purchase a "Hunter Education Deferral", and you must be accompanied.

**\*What does "accompanied" mean?** Accompanied means: By a person who is at least 17, who is licensed to hunt in Texas, who has passed hunter education **OR** is exempt (born before September 2, 1971), and you must be within normal voice control.

If you forget or misplace your hunting license prior to your arrival, our Wildlife Management team can direct you to a location in Granbury, Glen Rose or Stephenville prior to your hunt. **However, it will be more convenient for you if you obtain the license prior to your arrival.**
